The dissertation style requires the bottom margin be 1 inch and the page number be at the top of the 1 inch bottom margin, so it is 1 inch from the bottom of the page. I have set the Footer Margin in Page Setup to 1 inch, and the Page margin to 1 inch which I thought was the right way to set the margin to get the required margin. However, now I have a 2 inch margin at the page number and the text starts one line directly above the page number. What is the right way to get the bottom margin I need?
