To disable System Restore monitoring for a particular drive, try this:

1. Click Start, right-click My Computer, and then click Properties.
2. Click the System Restore tab.
3. Select the drive-letter from the list, and click Settings.
4. Select "Turn off System Restore on this drive"
5. Click OK twice to close the dialog.
