Never ever open a Bank account from a Public Internet cafe or common computers, you don't know how much buggy these machine are?.

1= Click start >> Control Panel >> Double Click Network and Internet Connections >> Double click Internet Options, on the IE Properties window you will see these Options:

Click on Connection Tab and be sure that your connection set to theproxy not to your Old Connection there.

Click on LAN button then Proxy and be sure the correct IP is set and retype
the password.

Also try this:

Open a Run Command and type in:

ipconfig /flushdns click [OK]

ipconfig /renew click [OK]

netsh winsock reset click [Ok]

Reboot your machine and try the connection, the Hotel Reception should help
in that?.
