I was on a trip for 4 weeks – home now and put together the video/pictures with MSFT Movie Maker.
I compiled my timeline and the timeline showed 1:15 min of avi video/ jpg pictures . I then clicked on "create on my PC " (or something similiar = save as wmv file on my PC) and it projected about 445mb and 800 minutes to finish !
I figured it would go down as it progressed. We went to dinner for a few hours – home now and still showing 167 minutes left. The process is using 99 % of CPU time – so far has used 2 hrs 45 min of CPU time. I have a 2ghz cpu with 1gb of memory and closed all other apps (I'm writing this offline since no NAV nor nic enabled right now). What can possibly take this so long. Is this typical ? or is " Something wrong with my setup" ?
I'm gonna let it run since it's so far into it, but what are my options ?
I have Nero 7 (has video record options – Vision, Recode etc)
Rather than wmv file, and since it's already in avi format (which means nothing to me), it any other public program better // quicker to use ?
