I have an XP desktop connected to an HP 3650 printer, which is shared. I'm running a simple wireless LAN (3Com) with two laptops which use the printer and an internet connection. Up until now this has given us no trouble, but now suddenly I can't print from one of the laptops, even a test page. The message given is "Test page failed to print" or for a normal print "Windows failed to print because of a problem in the print set-up". The printer still works on the desktop and, bizarrely, the other laptop. The network seems to be working fine in other respects – I can still access the internet and see shared files and folders, and I can ping the desktop from the laptop.

The thing that seems to have triggered this is that I installed a program called 'Ink Saver' on the desktop. I have now uninstalled it and done a 'system restore' but that hasn't solved the problem.

All suggestions considered.

Try uninstalling & reinstalling the printer.

Tried that with no change. Thanks anyway.
