P.S. I have tried using device manager to remove and and re-install it and it dosent work.

Have you looked to see if that reg cleaner has an undo feature? If not try using system restore to go to a recent restore point. SR backs up a copy of the registry.

This is just another example of why one should not sue a registry cleaner. They cause more harm than good.
