"Timothy Daniels" wrote:

...adding the following entry to the boot.ini file that you listed, using Notepad as your editor:

```
multi(0)disk(0)rdisk(1)partition(1)windows=  
"Microsoft Windows 2000" /fastdetect
```

Since your Win2K is probably in a folder named "WINNT", the 2nd entry should instead be:

```
multi(0)disk(0)rdisk(1)partition(1)\WINNT=  
"Microsoft Windows 2000" /fastdetect
```
