Insert your Windows installation CD and stop any autostart.
Go to Start => Run and type in (or copy/paste) the following:

```
expand -r E:\i386\luna.ms_ C:\Windows\Resources\Themes\Luna\
```

Where E: is the drive letter for your CD-ROM (change this letter if yours is different). There is space before and after -r and a space before C:

Go back to C:\Windows\Resources\Themes\Luna
There should now be a file called luna.mst
Rename this file to luna.msstyles

In Display Properties, change your theme to Classic => Apply
=> OK
In Display Properties, change your theme to Windows XP =>
Apply => OK
