Try this...

Open Notepad (or any item you want this for) to whatever size it becomes via the shortcut. Then drag the window corners to the monitor screen corners. Finally, click on the icon in the upper-left corner on the title bar, then select Close (Alt+F4) in its menu. This should reset the "normal" setting to come as close to maximized as possible.

Note that this works most of the time. I have errant windows which return to old settings and have to redo it now and then.
