Technical Information: Stop: 0*0000007E, pci.sys
check to be sure you have adequate disk space. if a dirver is identified in the stop message, disable driver or check with manufacture for driver update try changing video adapters.

so pls. provide me the solution how to format it and load Xp pro edition.

WinXP Pro cannot be installed "over" WinXP MCE, as no operating system I've ever heard of supports a downgrade.

Simply boot from the WinXP Pro installation CD. You'll be offered the opportunity to delete, create, and format partitions as part of the installation process. (You may need to re-arrange the order of boot devices in the PC's BIOS to boot from the CD.)
