Then Dell is probably right -- it's not the hardware. I would suggest that some app you have running in the background is occasionally sucking resources to a crawl. Or you are repeating some procedure that causes the problem. Diagnostics are difficult if it's a background app, but a judicious use of MSCONFIG might help you narrow down the problem. Prime suspects are anti-virus (what brand are you using?) and background monitoring apps like Dell's own "PC health" monitor (forget its actual name.)
