Hi I recently accepted a friend of mines hp pavillion ze5700 notebook to try and fix for him, well I got it home and started it up and first it said that the ntldr file is missing so I got my windows XP Pro disk out and tried to get the computer to boot from the disk so windows would come on but it always says setup could not complete and finally it is saying "the session manager initialization system process terminated unexpectidly with a status of 0Xc0000034 (0x00000000 0x00000000) Fatal system error!
I have tried to get it to the bios setup when it boots but nothing ever happens and I can't ever get to that point I have tried to do the R for the recovery console thingie but that hasn't worked either.
