Hi

I have a really strange problem with accessing a network share on a win2003 server.

The server has 3 network shares i.e. \\server\1 \\server\2 and \\server\3 All three shares has the same permissions. I can access 1 and 2 but not 3. I was able to connect to all 3 of them for just a week ago but now I cant connect to share 3. I am running xp pro sp2.

If I log in onto another xp pro sp2 with the same account, I can access all 3 shares so it isn't a permissions problem.

It seems like the share is blocked on my laptop. Is this possible?
Anyone got a clue?
