I'm having problems with minesweeper:

For some reason, it won't save my best times anymore.

I've beat my record many times in the last month, but it still won't update it.

(the most recent score on the best times list was 178 at 3/29/07 for the expert level, I just got 164 today (10/22/07))

I have windows XP professional and I have not modified minesweeper in any way (at least to my knowledge)

Don't really know what other information I should supply for a problem like this....

You are obviously an expert if you can achieve 164 seconds at the expert level! You now need a different type of expertise to fix your problem. For some reason the registry key used to store your Minesweeper score won't accept your updates. Its permissions are probably wrong. It is here:

HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Microsoft\winmine

Check the permissions, then set them to "Full Control" for yourself. When finished, manually set the result for "Time3" to 164.

Post again if this makes no sense to you.
