Hello all –

I had a problem with my main computer where it would boot extremely slowly, and sometimes reboot during startup. After progressively escalating problems, the machine finally refused to boot off of the disk. After trail-and-error testing the IDE disk, motherboard, and IDE cable, I decided that the problem was the motherboard, and replaced it.

Now the machine boots to the drive okay, but the machine reboots during startup. After seeing what was loading, I discovered that the machine reboots during a slight pause after it says it's loading mup.sys.

Of course, I can't boot into the machine to troubleshoot it; it reboots no matter what mode I boot into. Unfortunately I don't have a rescue disk. My installation CD has disappeared after several moves.

What might be causing this reboot?

If bet my problematic windows system disk on another system, is there a way I can edit the registry on it?
