Thanks again for your continued help. I have downloaded Avast as you suggest and will install it tomorrow evening and give it a try.

I have pasted the Event viewer logs showing the errors when I replicated the fault by running chkdsk on a reboot. The error in applications occurred 4 times within a few seconds – always the same error. The other 2 occurred once each.
