I've used WinXP Fax Console before, and it meets my basic needs without installing a 3rd party software application. My question relates to the actual internal PCI modem card. I've been looking at the Multi-Tech MultiModem ZPX V.92 internal controller-based modem which supports 33.6 FAX.

Having the capability of 33.6 FAX won't mean much. If the machine you are receiving from is only sending at a slower speed, then that's all you'll get. Same goes for sending... you will be restricted by the receive speed at the other end. I think most machines are working at 14.4.

You can use either of the modems you mentioned.
