How was Windows XP re-installed? If it was re-installed from the Windows XP recovery partition on the hard drive or from a recovery cdrom, then verify that wireless has been enabled in bios setup. If this does not resolve the problem, then locate and/or download the wireless modem drivers and install.

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OTOH, if Windows XP was re-installed from its own cdrom, then make sure that all of the required drivers have been installed from the utility cdrom that came with the laptop.
