A couple of days ago my 2nd PC, after "resume from hibernation" just sat at the black screen – the one with "Press F8 to delete restoration data", (after the long progress bar had travelled from left to right at the bottom of the screen), and I had to hold the power button in and force it to switch off.

...so it looks to me like hibernation is now, no longer working properly after SP3 :-) ...or should that be :-(

...I wonder if there'll be a patch soon, to fix what was not broken, and got broken with SP3 ?
