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NIS is NOT reliable. It's difficult to believe anything it reports.

IF ctfmon.exe was infected prior to the application of SP3, then NIS *\*should have been reporting\** it as infected then.

Since this issue occurred after applying SP3, then I'd be willing to bet my house that it's a False Positive.
