SvcHost is a container service that runs multiple smaller processes within it. Open a Command Prompt window and type

Tasklist /SVC

Will display all the individual services mapped to each SvcHost instance.

You can add User Profile Hive Cleanup to aid in closing your User hive and help XP shutdown/restart properly.
