Often times it has to do with what else is added to the context menu – meaning third party.

Having Spysweeper installed can cause this. Either way, see:

Also: can be due to updates 817287 and/or 821557

Check your settings here: Most users who face this issue can still right click the Start button, even though they can't right click on the Start Menu. Here is the workaround:

Right click the Start button, select Properties, Customize. Scroll through the options on the Advanced tab and put the check mark back in Enable dragging and dropping.

If your right clicking abilities are more complexed, run this edit.
