

Upgrading to Windows XP Home from Win95

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Now that XP will be phased out, I'd like to purchase an upgrade version to have around. I think I'll use it to install on a newly purchased Dell Vista laptop, because I don't care for Vista. I have an OEM version of XP that came on a Dell machine that I no longer use, but I know that I can't use it on a new laptop per the license.
