How do I rebuild the search index in Windows XP? I downloaded Windows Desktop Search, but searches are incomplete. I read that rebuilding the search index would eliminate this issue.

I was unable to use the following instructions:

- > Control Panel
- > System and Maintenance
- > Indexing Options
- > Advanced
- > Rebuild

because I don't have a "System and Maintenance" category when I click on Control Panel — and yes, I am looking at it in Category view, not Classic view.
