Domain Name System is the process for translating URL (Universal Resource Locator) into their respective IP Address. Your ISP has it's own DNS servers. OpenDNS is a service that provides an alternate DNS service (with filtering). Instead of using the default DNS servers of your ISP you substitute the OpenDNS servers. You do this by overriding the Automatic DNS server setup of your NIC and adding the two OpenDNS IP addresses as manual assignments.

It's normal to designate both a Primary and Secondary (Backup) DNS server.
