These include but are not limited to Ad-aware Pro Ad-Watch, Spybot Tea Timer, SpywareBlaster, SpySweeper, Spyware Doctor, CounterSpy, AVG Anti-Spyware, Norton AntiVirus, McAfee VirusScan and/or Antispyware, NOD32, and Zone Alarm (Free, Pro, & Security Suite).

Every now and then Windows Search 4.0 restore indexing locations. That is happened many times, and I am starting to be a little bit fed up. I have added some folders I like to keep indexed, and it will keep those folders indexed some time. But today again I noticed that indexing locations are restored to original and my folders are not indexed. :(
