At my place of work (big network) our IT department claims this option can't be used because we don't have admin rights & we have to do a reboot after we first turn on PC's in the morning. (v. annoying).

What worries me is that they thought it was installing on shut down, as they all have admin rights!!
Their checking procedures must be piss poor.

They can't even guarantee that the updates are installing correctly such is their lack of understanding.
