Thanks for responding. Yes I did google for "XP hangs at MUP.Sys" I tried every suggestion listed by tons of people who have had or are still having same problem. None worked. I noticed the ssystem would just automatically shut down after booting to certain point (MUP.sys) being the last display on the screen. As a last resort, I removed the hard drive and plugged it into another desktop running XP... did chkdsk /f. The system booted up Ok afterwards. However a certain problem remain... the system sort of freezes after running for say 5- 10 minutes. I am trying to fix that right now...
