

RE: can not uninstall hardware in safe mode

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You should try removing the card whilst the power is off, then boot up in normal mode, go to device manager and remove the device.

Make sure that the conflicting device is also removed, both physically and in device manager.

If there is any associated software, make sure you uninstall the software.

If the 'removal' is successful, you can restart the PC. Check that all the D Link items are still uninstalled / removed and then power off and reinstall the other devices.
