Right click My Computer/Properties/Advanced, click the Settings button in the startup and Recovery area, uncheck the box "automatically restart" in the System failure area, click OK and the reboot.

Try access the DVD writer, you may receive a BSOD instead of restarting. Write down the complete warning message and post back to the NG so that someone may help you.
