Graphics that came with it Intel 82815 Graphics Controller (driver Microsoft Corp) which I presume is built into the motherboard.

When I plugged in my Packard Bell 1015 monitor (yes, I know it's ancient before all the smart arses start jumping down my throat, but it's been fine before) I got the usual scramble, booted into vga mode, then windows says 'I can configure resolution better' etc etc
