My cdrom is not recognized by My Computer, device manager and BIOS. The last thing that happened was that I put an mp3 cd in the drive and it just stopped working. This has happened before but usually once I start Add Hardware Wizard or restart my system it starts working again. I've tried System Restore but the problem seems to have affected that too because I can't restore the system either. I've tried 5 restore points. Last good configuration has not worked either.

I am using Windows XP Professional with SP2 on a Pentium 4 system. My system is Gateway 7322GZ.

I went to System Information and saw that the cdrom driver is not started.

I would be extremely grateful for any help.

I have a Laptop does the same thing on a regular basis – cheap rubbish it is.

The CD ROM drive does not quite connect properly in its IDE slot and gets jolted loose, I can mostly fix it by pressing on the sides of the drive quite hard and wiggling it till CD ROM shows up in My Computer. Occasionally I have to take the thing apart and re-seat the drive.
