

Second hard drive causing blue screen error

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I have two hard drives. I was using one for storage and the other to run WindowsXP. I received a "blue screen" error on the Windows drive and was unable to reboot without the error re-appearing.

I then disconnected that drive and installed windows on the other drive with the intention of recovering files off the first. This is where my issue begins. When I hook up 4-pin cord as well as the 20/24-pin cord the pc reboots and I get the blue screen error.

I thought that I would be able to hook up the old drive and access files as if the drive was storage.

Is there a way I can access this drive as if it were storage? What may be causing the error? Are two instances of Windows XP trying to run on reboot?
