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Have an Advent 7096 laptop with integrated ATI Radeon Express 200M graphics, XP Media Center with all updates.

Installed these newer drivers:

During install was informed I needed NET Framework 2 which I downloaded and installed after the graphics drivers.

I now have something called Catalyst Control Centre in my Programs list. I have no idea what this is because I get an error trying to open it.
