Hello, I recently edited my right-click association for .html files so that when I right click on a file of that type, and choose EDIT, it sends the file to the editor of my choice. I initially had an error in that association, and for a short time the file would not open at all. I decided to delete that menu option, and re-enter it with the correct path to the editor.
