1. Start
2. Run
3. Regedit
4. My computer
5. HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE
6. Software
7. Microsoft
8. Windows NT
9. Current Version
10. WINLOGON
11. Userinit (On the right hand side)
12. Make sure this says (Userinit) C:\WINDOWS\system32\userinit.exe: If it says anything after this, remove the extra.
