I have encountered a problem I can not seem to fix. When I scan my system for spyware/other unwanted crap with Ad-Aware a "System Shutdown" prompt comes up and proceeds to restart my computer after 1 minute. The top text of the prompt basically says to save all work currently open and "The Shutdown was initiated by NT AUTHORITY\SYSTEM". The bottom text of the prompt says "Windows must now restart because the Remote Procedure Call (RPC) service terminated unexpectedly. I have scanned my system with Ad-Aware on numerous occasions without this failure occurring. Can someone please help me determine what is causing this problem. Thanks.
