How to Enable Pop-ups:

The above issue can occur, if you have not enabled Activex scripts or java scripts.

Try enabling the scripts in IE by following the steps given below:

- 1.Open IE and click Tools and select Internet Options.
- 2.Click Security and click Custom level.
- 3.Scroll down the tab and enable all the options under "Activex control and plugins".
- 4.Also enable the options under "Java VM" in the scroll list.
- 5.Click Ok.
