Zone Alarm 5.1 interfaces perfectly with the Windows firewall. You do not need to do anything. The windows firewall is turned on by default as the system loads; once Zone alarm has loaded, it reports back to Windows and the Windows firewall is automatically shut off.

Any version of Zone Alarm prior to 5.1 does not intercafe in this way with the Windows firewall (or so I have heard; I had 5.1 installed brfore I installed SP2).
