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Hi,

I would speculate that one of the updates you installed was the .net framework. It adds a user account to the system, and thus causes a logon prompt when the system is rebooted. Click start/run, type "control userpasswords2" (without the quotes) and click ok. Uncheck the box requiring a username and password, click apply/ok and follow the prompts to set up a default logon.
