> is because the images are for sample only and they link to the .psp file of
> that .gif/.jpg for us to download and create other graphics with.
>
> Anyway, I can't figure out how to fix this so that I can choose where to
> save. I thought I could deal with it by going to My Computer >Toos > Folder
> Options > File Extensions and changing the .psp extension to open with Paint
> Shop Pro. Instead, PSP can't open this file because "it cannot find the
> temporary folder it says it's downloading to.

> I am going nuts. I have searched for this problem on the 'net to no avail.
> I have posted my problem anywhere I can, hoping to find a solution. If
> anyone has one PLEASE let me know. Any help will be appreciated!
