>I was one of many here whose ftp uploads suddenly stopped working when Windows Update installed a number of Windows XP SP2 updates

>in late April. With help from Microsoft's e-mail tech support I finally isolated and blocked the offending update, KB893066. It's

>described in the following article:

>

> MS05-019: Vulnerabilities in TCP/IP could allow remote code execution and denial of service

>

> The short version of the solution that worked for my PC:

>

> 1. Do a system restore to (or before) the restore point set when these updates were installed. FTP uploads work again.

>

> 2. (quoting from the last of many e-mails from Microsoft tech support)

> Please access Windows Update via the following link:

> <http://windowsupdate.microsoft.com/>

>

> After scanning the system, please select Custom Install. In the list of

> updates, uncheck the check box before Security Update for Windows XP

> (KB893066) and check "Hide this update". (end quote)

>

> 3. Install the other updates if you wish and make sure that ftp uploads still work. They had me test them one by one – that's

> how I identified the culprit – but with luck your problem matches mine and the above will solve it more quickly.
