As soon as a printer is added, or during the process of adding a printer, the spooler gets stopped. Not sure what's causing it and the Event Viewer doesn't show any useful information other than it tells the spooler service has been stopped x times.

I'm not sure where to start so hopefully someone may have an answer to this, thanks.
