> New Motherboard---Windows XP can't log on, it show logon safe mode or
> normal start, but I try two and it still reboot again. Then I use XP CD
> and choose R to fix C (chkdsk c: /r and fixboot c:), after I use fixboot
> c and it still says c is NTFS, but it still cant log on.

> So, I use XP CD to install XP and didnt format c(choose "install XP"
> and Fix XP) , just reinstall XP to fix system file. It still also cant
> log on.

> Then I use old motherboard, windows XP also cant log on, I use XP CD to
> fixboot c again, bit this time it c says c is FAT.

>

> I unplug and plug to another computer to see partition. This computer
> says this harddisk only had one 10MB and FAT, but control panel/system
> management tool says this harddisk is 80GB.

>

> But I am sure I didnt format C or D.

>

> Because the data is very important for me.

> Please help me....

> Please tell me any idea to fix partition table.
