>> error
>> screen stated that AutoChk.Exe could not be found.
>> It gave it's path '~\system32\' , and said that the AutoCheck would be
>> skipped.
>> Windows loaded and all was ok. The error message has appeared every boot
>> since.

>> i believe the scan was initiated by diskkeeper (to do a system level
>> defrag). removing the task from diskkeeper did not resolve.
>> Diskkeeper has since been uninstalled.
>> i am running WinXP SP2
>> i have searched for autochk.exe and it is in the srstem32 folder, where
>> the
>> error message claims it not to be.
