So the DVD re-writer, card readers etc are still in place.

It might be a silly question, but in the case of my laptop is it still OK to upgrade ?

Thanks in advance,

Internal card readers can cause problems with how drive letters get assigned. If they can't be disconnected make sure there are no memory cards in the reader during the upgrade or install.
