Have installed NAV2006 3-user license version on a couple of 3 computers which are for all intents and purposes are mostly identical. On one of them, everything seems to be fine so far (after disabling their stupid protection center and reactivating the XP security center). On the other two, everytime I try to access the control panel through the start menu, I get an 'encountered error, send info to Daddy Gates' box.
