In the System Configuration Utility I enabled all the "Services" and I want to change it back to the original configuration or to the ones that were originally checkmarked. System Restore cannot help because I already used it once.

PS: Services listed in the system config utility are already enabled – that's why they're listed in this tool. They may not be running (show a "stopped" status) but they are enabled.

Try to refrain from using this tool for managing services. It's okay for temporary suspension of a service for troubleshooting. Instead, use the "Services" snap-in located in the Administrative Tools.
