I just got back from a trip, so my computer wasn't used for about 5 days. When I turned on the computer, I got to the motherboard display, and then to the Windows XP loading screen. After it loads, the monitor then displayed a black screen, not losing connection or cable disconnected. I restarted several times and even tried Last Known Good Configuration, and it still went to the black screen. Afterwards, I used Safe Mode and I was able to get in. I checked Event Viewer and I got these errors in succession:

The person on the phone told me to enter again in Safe Mode and uninstall the NVIDIA Display Adapters from the Device Manager (none of the hardware had any ! signs beside them). After I did so and restarted, for some reason I got in now. And he now claims it was a Corrupted Display Driver.
