Hi Ron, There the ones at the top keep changing but svchost.exe is from 75% to 99% so I think that is where the problem lies.

Sounds like it all right. Problem is that there are always multiple instances of SVCHOST running and each instance can have as many as 24 separate services running under it.

On the processes tab make note of the PID number for the problem instance of SVCHOST.

Then open a Command Prompt window and enter the following command:

```
TASKLIST /SVC
```

Locate the PID number for the problem instance of svchost and make note of the names of the services that are running under it. Post that information back here.
